Mosquito Abatement Tire Drives set

The Saginaw County Mosquito Abatement Commission has announced its summer tire drive locations and details. These collections are open to Saginaw County residents (not businesses) and will accept up to ten tires per property, per year. Residents must present photo ID to prove county residency. Rims must be removed from tires, and only tires from cars, trucks, motorcycles, and bikes will be accepted. SCMAC does not accept semi, tractor, or heavy equipment tires. The drives will be held June 18-22 from 8 am to 2:30 pm and July 16-20, from 1 pm to 7 pm.
