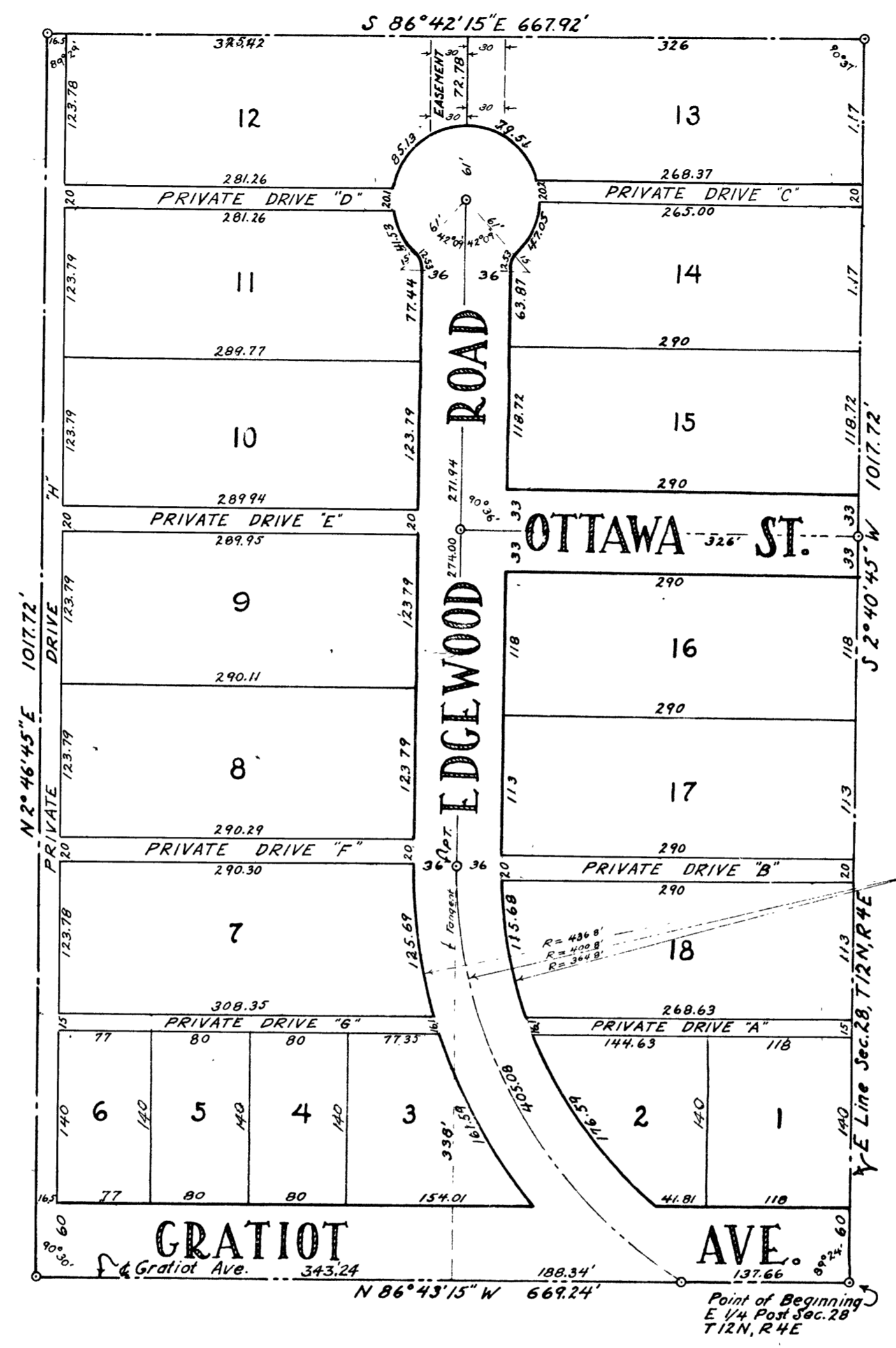

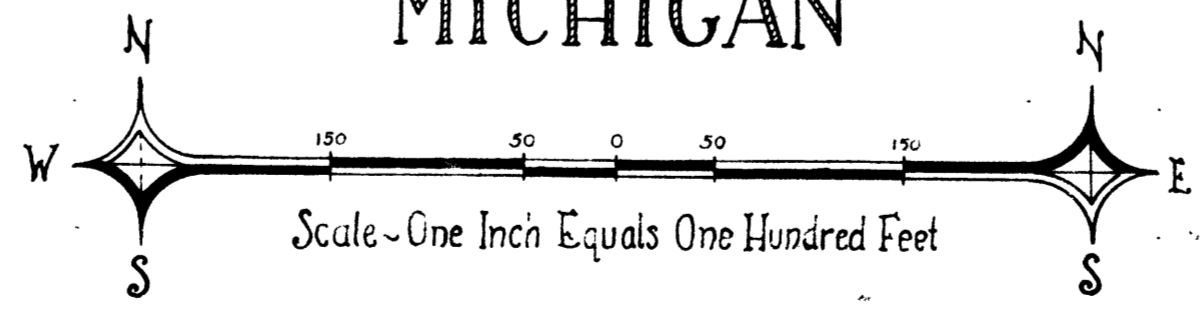
**SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE**
