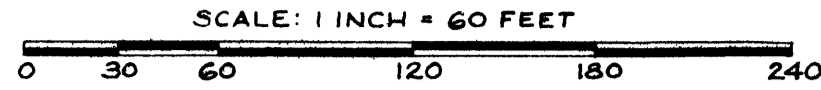


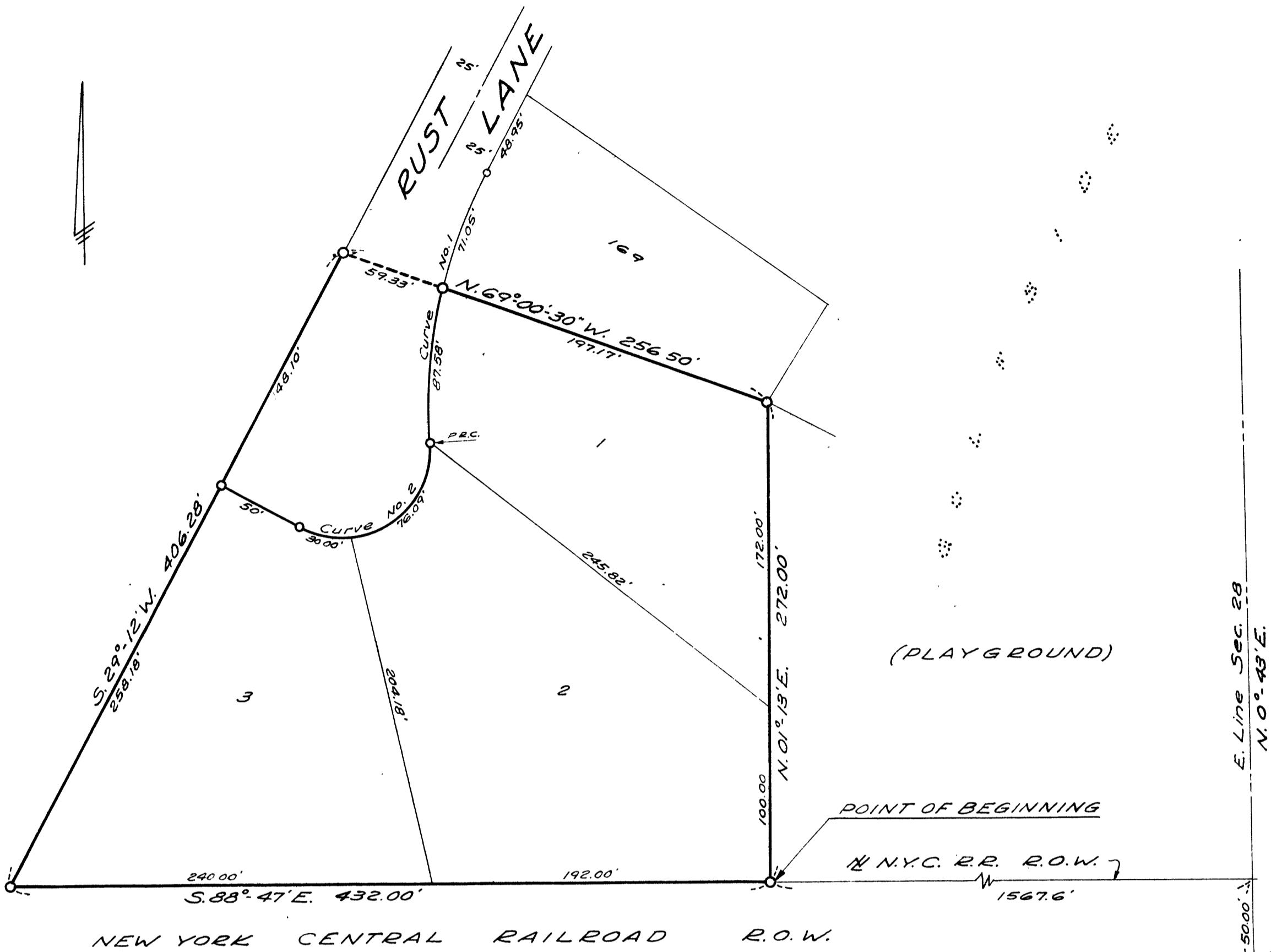

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of SCHULWITZ ADDITION, Section 28, Township 12 North, Range 4 East, Saginaw Township, Saginaw County, Michigan, is described as follows; Beginning at a point on the North line of the New York Central Railroad right-of-way 1667.60 feet Westerly along said line from the East line of said Section 28, and 50.00 feet North of the South line of said Section; thence N.01°-13'E., 272.00 feet to the Southeasterly corner of Lot 169 of the plat of Golfside, Saginaw Township, Saginaw County, Michigan; thence N.69°-00'-30"W., on the Southerly line of said Lot 169 and on said line extended, 256.50 feet to the Westerly line of said plat of Golfside; thence S.29°-12'W., on said Westerly line extended, 406.28 feet to the North line of the New York Central Railroad right-of-way; thence S.88°-47'E., along said railroad right-of-way 432.00 feet to the point of beginning.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one and that permanent metal monuments consisting of bars not less than one-half inch in diameter and 48 inches in length, or shorter bars of not less than one-half inch in diameter lapped over each other at least 6 inches with an over-all length of not less than 48 inches, encased in a concrete cylinder at least 4 inches in diameter and 48 inches in depth have been placed at points marked thus o as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, at the intersection of the street with the boundaries of the plat and at points of curvature and points of tangency of street lines as shown on said plat.
