televisions, monitors, laptops, hard drives, keyboards, mice, cords, cables, printers, external drives, tablets, phones, fax machines
9 am - 1 pm

First Tuesday of the month: May 1, June 5,
July 10 (due to Independence Day holiday), August 7, September 4

Paint Wednesdays

oil-based, acrylic, latex and spray paint, varnish/stain, caulk
9 am - 1 pm

Second Wednesday of the month
May 9, June 13, July 11, August 8, September 12

Household Hazardous Waste

motor oil, acids, gasoline, aerosols, antifreeze, fluorescent bulbs, smoke detectors, glues, lawn/garden chemicals, mercury, kerosene, unwanted prescription and OTC medications

All in One Drop-Off Days

Household Hazardous Waste, Electronics, Paint

Tuesday, May 22 from 3 pm to 7 pm

Saturday, June 23 from 9 am to 1 pm

Wednesday, July 25 from 3 pm to 7 pm

Saturday, August 25 from 9 am to 1 pm

Thursday, September 27 from 3 pm to 7 pm

NEW! Document Shredding & Foam Recycling

Limited to two banker's box or the equivalent per person

Also accepting clean foam items including cups, containers, block packaging, egg cartons, ice chests/coolers, but NO packing peanuts

Thursdays, May 17 and September 20 from 3 pm to 7 pm

Bring **ONLY** accepted materials on the appropriate day.

EXAMPLE:

Residents bringing paint to an electronics collection event will be directed to return on the correct drop-off day.

If you need to dispose of items from more than one category, please bring them to the All in One Drop-Off Days.

HOUSEHOLD Special Waste Program Rules:

Proof of Residency required
No farms, schools or businesses
No containers over 5 gallons
Containers will not be returned

Do NOT bring:
CRT tubes removed from televisions
Propane tanks
Explosives
Ammunition
Tires
Asbestos

We cannot accept unknown or unlabeled wastes at public drop-off events. If you have unknown chemicals, please call (989) 781-9555 to schedule an appointment.

SAFE TRANSPORTATION REMINDERS

*Do not mix
different chemicals!*

*Leave substances in
their original containers, and
make sure caps and/or lids
are securely closed.*

*Place containers in
sturdy boxes in an
upright position. Do not
place items in
plastic trash bags.*

*Never transport
leaking or open containers.*

If line of cars is near edge of property, come back later during event or on another scheduled drop-off day. Do not line up on or block road. Events close promptly at advertised end time- no cars will be allowed on site after that time.
