The Saginaw County Mosquito Abatement Commission will be conducting their first household scrap tire drive of the summer during the week of June 20 - 24, 2016 from 8:00am to 2:30pm at the following locations:

Monday, June 20 – TA Truck Stop, 6364 Dixie Hwy, Bridgeport

Tuesday, June 21 – St. Charles Township Hall, 1003 N. Saginaw Street, St. Charles

Wednesday, June 22 – Albee Township Community Center, 10645 East Rd. (M-13), Albee Township

Thursday, June 23 – James Township Hall, 6060 Swan Creek Road, James Township

Friday, June 24 – Frankenmuth Township Hall, 210 W. Genesee, Frankenmuth

The program is open to all Saginaw County property owners at no cost. All tire drop-offs must meet the following criteria:

1. Saginaw County residents only (must provide State issued I.D. or Driver's License).
2. Tires are limited to household tires, passenger size only (car and pickup truck) without rims.
3. Residents limited to 10 tires per address, per year.
4. Oversized tires are NOT accepted (semi, tractor, or heavy equipment).
5. SCMAC does NOT accept tires from businesses or other revenue generating enterprises such as agriculture and contracting operations.

Scrap tires are ideal mosquito breeding habitat for both nuisance and disease carrying mosquitoes. SCMAC's scrap tire program is part of our Source Reduction effort, and annually results in thousands of tires being collected from Saginaw County property owners and communities. All collected tires are transported to Environmental Rubber Recycling in Flint where they are shredded and used in various capacities.
