- Attend 3-4 days of free tax preparation training in January
- Become IRS certified in basic and advanced tax preparation
- Commit to volunteer a minimum of one day a week, during the 11 week tax season at a VITA site

- Work one-on-one with families, saving them money and protecting them from predatory practices
- Help your community and the local economy
- Help families and individuals on their path toward financial stability
